** For College Credit Plus (CC+) classes, acceptance into the intended college is required. Students have the option of taking any college courses for which they meet the pre-requisites. Students may take classes from multiple colleges and not just those listed on the course selection sheet. The course selection sheet highlights the classes that, assuming there is sufficient interest, will be offered at WKHS next year.

All students interested in participating in CC+ must attend a College Credit Plus information counseling session with a parent/ guardian. Worthington hosted one of these nights on January 10th. Students who attended this meeting fulfilled the state's requirement. Students who did not attend and still hope to participate in a CC+ class, can pick up forms and watch the video of the presentation on the Counselor website.

Prior to registering for any CC+ courses, students are encouraged to investigate how the credits will transfer to their future anticipated college. Many entry-level courses earned at Ohio public colleges are guaranteed to transfer to any other Ohio public college. Students who wish to earn credits at a private college or those who want to transfer credits to an out-of-state institution, will need to have their CC+ transcripts evaluated on a case-by-case basis by the institution they are seeking to attend.
