- Submit a completed application form.
- Attend an accredited four year college or university, on a full-time basis by the end of 2018.
- Demonstrate aptitude and/or interest in math or science and plan to study a related field of study.
- Be available to participate in an in-person interview should he/she become a finalist.

Candidates must submit Application to the guidance office at **WKHS by April 13, 2018.**

Applications will be reviewed and finalists selected. Finalists will be contacted for an in-person interview. Interviews will be weighted most heavily in the selection.
