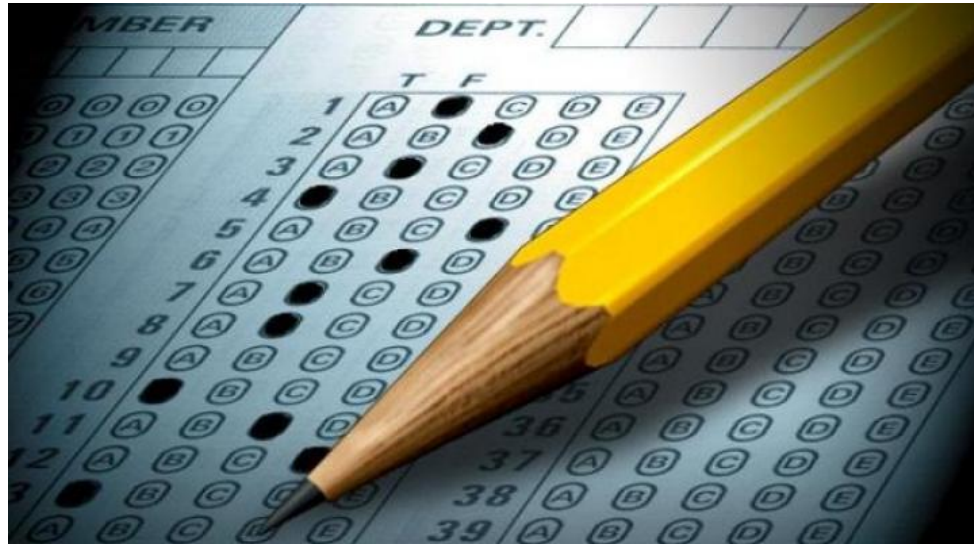


Testing 101

PSAT, PreACT, ACT, and SAT



The ACT

- English, Math, Reading and Science scores ranging from 1 – 36
- Composite score
-average of the four section scores – ranges from 1 – 36
- Optional writing test



The SAT



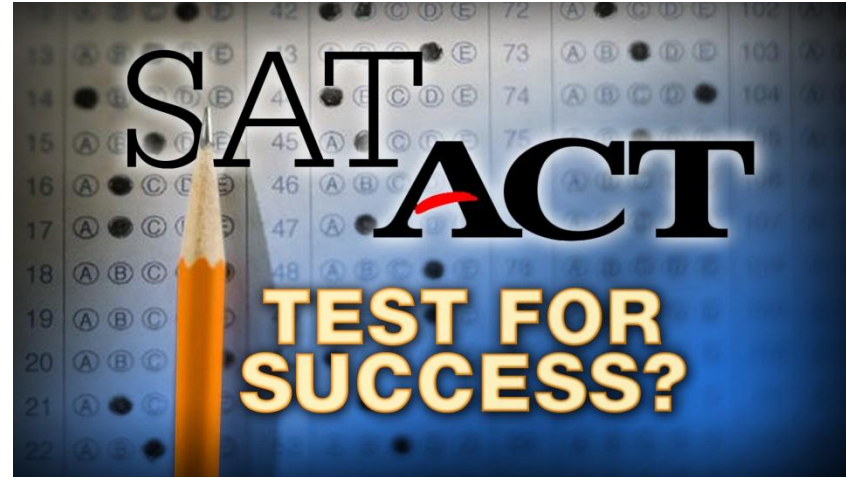
- Evidence Based Reading and Math scores ranging from 200 - 800
- Overall score ranges from 400 - 1600

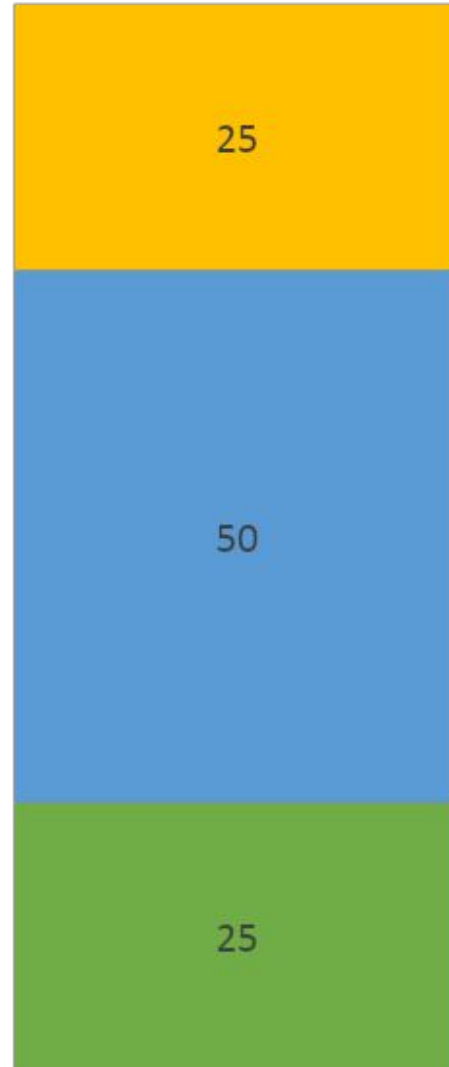
College Readiness Scores

- Middle 50%

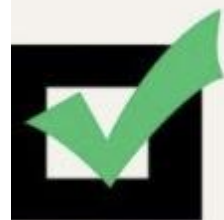


Super-Scoring

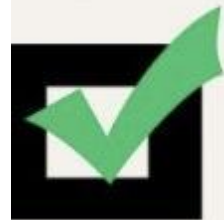
ACT Test Date	June	Sept	Superscore

Reading	28	25	28
Science	30	32	32
Composite	29	29	31

Test Optional

- Student applications will be reviewed as a part of a holistic review that will not disadvantage any student without a test score.
 - Higher emphasis on other factors
 - Some saying “test optional” and really “test flexible”
 - Need to look closely at individual college
 - Some will still want for scholarship consideration
